Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **declined by 0.9%** since 2017, falling by 12,482. Population is expected to **decrease by 0.1%** between 2022 and 2027, losing 1,460.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.1% in Appalachian Power Company-Served Virginia Counties from 579,049 to 566,796. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 4.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 58.5% to 59.2% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **16.6% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (4.2% below the national average), and **9.7% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.9% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (State Government), and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).







Unemployment by Gender












Unemployment Rate Trends





As of 2020, 1,914 people have migrated from Charlottesville City County, VA to Appalachian Power Company-Served Virginia Counties. In the same year, 1,154 people left Appalachian Power Company-Served Virginia Counties migrating to Charlottesville City County, VA. The total Net Migration for Appalachian Power Company-Served Virginia Counties in 2020 was 2,169.










Top Growing Occupations




Top Occupation Location Quotient




