Population decreased by 30,396 over the last 5 years but is projected to grow by 51 over the next 5 years.

Regional average earnings per job are **\$18.8K below** the national average earnings of \$79.8K per job.


Takeaways

- As of 2022 the region's population **declined by 3.3**% since 2017, falling by 30,396. Population is expected to **increase by 0.0**% between 2022 and 2027, adding 51.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 5.1% in Appalachian Power Company-Served West Virginia Counties from 391,632 to 371,755. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 7.5%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 50.8% to 51.6% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **12.8% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.9% below the national average), and **7.8% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.1% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, General Medical and Surgical Hospitals, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).






Unemployment by Gender




Unemployment by Race

Unemployment by Ethnicity









Labor Force Participation Rate Trends










Retiring Soon












Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP









Educational Pipeline


