As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate decreased from 61.1% to 60.6% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **19.0% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (1.8% below the national average), and **10.0% hold an Associate's Degree** (1.1% above the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and General Medical and Surgical Hospitals.







Unemployment by Gender




























