Regional average earnings per job are **\$14.5K below** the national average earnings of \$79.8K per job.

#### **Takeaways**

- As of 2022 the region's population increased by 5.3% since 2017, growing by 44,079. Population is expected to increase by 5.5% between 2022 and 2027, adding 47,684.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs increased by 6.0% in Southwestern Electric Power Company-Served Arkansas Counties from 402,875 to 427,180. This change outpaced the national growth rate of 2.4% by 3.6%. As the number of jobs increased, the labor force participation rate decreased from 62.3% to 61.6% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **18.6% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (2.2% below the national average), and **6.9% hold an Associate's Degree** (2.0% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Management of Companies and Enterprises, and Education and Hospitals (Local Government).




#### Sep 2022 Labor Force Breakdown







## **Unemployment by Gender**









#### **Job Trends**








#### Millennials
















#### **Top Industry Location Quotient**







#### Unique Average Monthly Postings










## **Educational Pipeline**
