Population decreased by 29,384 over the last 5 years and is projected to decrease by 24,573 over the next 5 years.


- As of 2022 the region's population **declined by 4.8%** since 2017, falling by 29,384. Population is expected to **decrease by 4.2%** between 2022 and 2027, losing 24,573.
- From 2017 to 2022, jobs declined by 2.9% in Southwestern Electric Power Company-Served Louisiana Counties from 257,792 to 250,392. This change fell short of the national growth rate of 2.4% by 5.3%. As the number of jobs declined, the labor force participation rate increased from 55.0% to 57.3% between 2017 and 2022.
- Concerning educational attainment, **13.5% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree** (7.3% below the national average), and **8.5% hold an Associate's Degree** (0.4% below the national average).
- The top three industries in 2022 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Federal Government, Military.






Unemployment by Gender



Unemployment by Ethnicity







Job Trends



Labor Force Participation Rate Trends






Retiring Soon






Inbound and Outbound Migration








Top Growing Industries






Top Industry Location Quotient






Top Industry GRP















Top Posted Occupations

Unique Average Monthly Postings






Educational Pipeline
